

## **Ten Questions To Ask *Before* You Write Your Proposal!**

- 1. Is there a need for this project and if so, do I understand the root cause of the problem (need) and can I substantiate it?**
- 2. How does my project directly and effectively respond to this need both theoretically and technically and is it supported by relevant literature and best practices?**
- 3. What are the desired outcomes of my project? How will I measure success?**
- 4. What activities will I undertake to achieve these outcomes and what are resources required to do these activities? How much will it cost?**
- 5. Who can best do this project? Me, others, a collaborative effort?**
- 6. Am I eligible to receive a grant from the Endowment?**
- 7. Do the Endowment's mission, values, desired outcomes and priorities align with my project and my organization?**
- 8. Is my project eligible for funding?**
- 9. What type of Endowment grant best matches my needs, if at all?**
- 10. Is the scope and size of my project compatible with Endowment grants?**
